


WHY BUY A CERTIFIED TOYOTA?

How Certified Toyotas Are Different from Used Cars

If you're in the market for a used car, you've got a lot of research to conduct. You not only have to explore your options, but also explore the quality of the vehicles that are available. You may not be able to research the quality of the exact vehicle online, but you can research the year, model, and trim to get a sense of what it offers, how well reviewed it is, and even its Kelley Blue Book® value. You can pretty much get a sense of what to expect before you actually see the vehicle in-person.

To make sure you are getting a top-quality car, there are many ways you can conduct the necessary research, such as asking for a vehicle history report to check its maintenance log. You can also give its interior and exterior a closer look to notice any scratches, tears, or dents. However, if it passes the visual inspection, you can move on to the test drive to get a feel for how the Toyota car performs and handles the road.

Although doing the recommended research and inspections may take time, it's worth it when it comes to purchasing your next ride. You want to be sure that there's both quality and reliability to your purchase.

Certified Used Toyota Vehicles are much different than used cars in a variety of ways. Most certified Toyota models are relatively newer, typically below six years old. Also, if the vehicles have more than 85,000 miles on them, they aren't eligible for the certification process, so

certified vehicles will have low mileage, too.

The major difference between used vehicles and certified Toyota vehicles is the inspection. Used cars do go through a quick multi-point inspection to assess any damage or faulty components before being put into the inventory. However, certified Toyota models are subjected to a meticulous 160-point inspection to ensure their quality and value for drivers. The inspections on the certified Toyota models are much more thorough than traditional used vehicles, so you can bet that the certified Toyota models will be in better shape.

The Toyota Certification Process

Certified Toyota models are inspected thoroughly to ensure that they're of a quality deserving the "certified" designation; however, the vehicle must meet the age and mileage requirements first. Once the vehicle meets those requirements, expert technicians will pop the hood, put the vehicle on the lift, and carefully look through every inch of the vehicle to spot any issues or problems that may prevent the vehicle from passing the certification inspection. Once the technician thoroughly inspects the vehicle and its components, it officially becomes a certified Toyota.

The 160-point inspection involves checking a variety of systems and components, including:

- Audio and alarm systems
- Battery system
- Emissions and state inspection
- Engine compartment
- Engine coolant and HVAC System
- Exterior Condition and appearance
- Frame, structure, and underbody
- *Hybrid components
- Instrument panel and electronics system

- Interior conditions and appearance
- Lighting systems
- Steering system
- Tires and suspension system
- Transmission and transaxle
- Trunk compartment
- Vehicle history
- Additional items and systems (i.e. navigation, sunroof, etc.)

By conducting this thorough inspection of the vehicle, its systems, components, and engine, the technicians can be sure that the Toyota is of a quality deserving of the certification and the spot on the dealership's lot—and, potentially, your next car.



Included Warranties & Amenities


Another major advantage that certified Toyota models have over traditional used cars is the included warranties. Each Certified Used Toyota model comes equipped with some substantial coverage that can help you throughout your ownership. Most used car purchases require additional fees for any extended coverage, but with certified Toyota models, these warranties are included with the sales price.

12-Month/12,000-Mile Comprehensive Warranty

For the first year of ownership—or 12,000 miles on the vehicle, whichever comes first—you get comprehensive coverage for any repair or replacement for components that fail under normal use due to any possible defect or improper installation. Should any component fail from a manufacturer error, the warranty covers the cost of the replacement component and installation. The warranty is transferable, too, at no cost.

7-Year/100,000-Mile Limited Powertrain Warranty

This warranty begins on January 1st of the model year and expires at seven years or 100,000 miles, whichever comes first. This warranty covers any major engine and transmission components, and all internally lubricated parts. The warranty offers travel protection, including meal and lodging reimbursement when you're more than 150 miles from your home or dealership. It even includes substitute transportation while your vehicle is in the shop for repairs. Like the 12-Month/12,000-mile Comprehensive Warranty, this coverage is also transferable.





One Year of Roadside Assistance

This coverage begins the date of your Certified Used Toyota purchase. It covers most roadside services like flat tire repair, lockout service, jump starting, emergency fuel delivery, and reimbursement for towing to the closest Toyota dealership. These services are available 24 hours a day and 356 days a year.

CARFAX® Vehicle History Report™

The purchase of a Certified Used Toyota Vehicle also comes with a CARFAX® Vehicle History Report. This document gives you some detailed insight into the vehicle and its previous ownership. It'll list the scheduled maintenance and services that were performed on the vehicle, so you'll know if it was properly maintained. The CARFAX® Vehicle History Report™ will also list any added parts, components, or any accidents that the vehicle may have been involved with under the previous ownership.
